get lucky is mark knopfler s fifth studio album of the decade and represents a beautifully crafted exploration of a lifetime of musical roots fluently combining folk and blues with his original song writing and vivid observational lyricism all the songs from the album are here arranged for guitar tab complete with full lyrics accompanying standard notation and melody lines

this book is a snapshot pictorial performance history of what is possibly george dreyfus's most frequently played composition the adventures of sebastian the fox the music first appeared in 1963 as accompaniment to tim burstall's 13 episode children's television series for which dreyfus wrote some 120 minutes of music in 1968 he made a suite consisting of eight of the main musical pieces which he subsequently arranged for a dozen different ensembles many of which have been recorded the movements of the suite are connected by short descriptive narrations particularly suitable for children these exist in english german chinese russian hebrew and yiddish indicating the performances the suite has had throughout the world within australia throughout europe and from china to paraguay dreyfus a bassoon player has personally used the suite over the 60 years since it was created as a vehicle for making music with and for young people in a variety of educational situations in metropolitan regional and outback australia on tours and in residencies in europe and china in 2005 dreyfus and his composer son jonathan created arrangements for small ensemble of the music for four episodes of the original tv series which were then performed live to film to youth theatre audiences and school groups throughout australia in germany and in switzerland the adventures of sebastian the fox has represented australian music in many countries has brought enjoyment to hundreds if not thousands of listeners appeals across generations and has proved uniquely durable the photographs capture a selection of many different performance situations they are at once a celebration of music making and a tribute to the joyous democratic resourcefulness of the composer

the fourth ragtime mystery is filled with warmth and wonder and interesting music trivia buoyed by the relationship between the two sleuths which may well echo that between the late larry karp and his son who finished this final installment after his death kirkus reviews it takes one moment in 2016 for ragtime music expert alan chandler to go from sitting in his hotel room in sedalia missouri to standing beside the king of ragtime scott joplin at his upright piano in 1899 chandler suddenly finds himself more than one hundred years earlier inside the famous maple leaf club with its gas chandeliers massive walnut bar gaming tables and pals surrounding the noted pianist and composer what in the hell is going on am i dreaming clearly something unexpected is going on for chandler in the fourth and final ragtime mystery by father and son larry karp and casey karp a longtime friend mickey potash phones chandler top ragtime performer and national expert on joplin to say that a duffel filled with joplin's handwritten music has surfaced chandler and his grandson tom race from seattle to sedalia to evaluate what may be the most important find in popular american music potash shows them initial pages which look authentic but before they can get the duffel hidden in a padlocked closet he is tortured and murdered the duffel is stolen disappointment encourages a resurgence of symptoms in chandler's stage 4 cancer he's determined to validate the music before time runs out tom and later his wife miriam help him another murder complicates their investigation the trail to the duffel is crowded jackson and saramae two young people with journalism in their blood want to solve the crime as do homicide detectives and antique shopkeepers not surprisingly the roots of the lost music lie in past emotional conflict now tangled in genealogical warfare

traveled a map he used to find a road of own a road he knew for a fact would pave the way to a college scholarship and a future in basketball but that was before tonight because despite all sawyer s careful planning his map sends him down a road toward an obstacle he never sees coming an obstacle that slams him head on and reveals a fate worse than failure success now broken bleeding and running out of time sawyer is forced to make a new list a simple list with only one strategy live long enough to fail

i have completed this manuscript just remember this or as american pop singers 1900 1950 about music before the 1950s in america it perhaps offers knowledge and insights not previously found in other musical reference books i have moreover been working on this book very meticulously over the past twelve plus years it started as a bit of fun and gradually became serious as i began to listen along with the vocalists of popular music of the era before 1950 essentially just before the dawn of rock and roll if you can call it that indeed genre and labeling of american music started here and then from everywhere while the old adage of always starting from somewhere could be noted in every century the 1900s had produced the technology understanding the necessity more so finds a curiosity on the part of a general public hungry for entertainment despite 6 day work weeks world war i the great depression and world war ii

set in chicago s wicker park and rural michigan jethro is an old fashioned story told in modern language about love music and finding one s real voice i first met jethro at the hide out which is a chicago bar that looks like an old roadhouse dropped down into a post industrial landscape it was a fluky april fool s day with a temperature of about eighty and spring was coming in with a vengeance all beneath a moon so huge and orange yellow it seemed surreal you knew that with so many elements conspiring something strange was bound to happen that even once the temperature went back to normal and the moon began to shrink you and your life would have changed course and you simply would not be the same from jethro

a calculus two exam at 7 30 a m is insane was my thought as i sat down to breakfast in the lsu union hall i looked up at one of the tvs just in time to see the second plane crash into the world trade center my heart sank to my toes i thought as a truck driver in the louisiana national guard active duty consisted of dealing with hurricanes and floods not war that is what the army is for i m still in school perhaps my contract will be up in time national guard truck drivers are not war heroes little did i know that a phone call in the middle of a blind date would prove me so wrong now that an active duty deployment to iraq is in my future my concern is will i be the same person when i come back from the journals i kept daily this is a walk in my boots
