dear brother jane manning james wrote to joseph f smith in 1903 i take this opportunity of writing to ask you if i can get my endowments and also finish the work i have begun for my dead your sister in the gospel jane e james a faithful latter day saint since her conversion sixty years earlier james had made this request several times before to no avail and this time she would be just as unsuccessful even though most latter day saints were allowed to participate in the endowment ritual in the temple as a matter of course james unlike most mormons was black for that reason she was barred from performing the temple rituals that latter day saints believe are necessary to reach the highest degrees of glory after death a free black woman from connecticut james positioned herself at the center of lds history with uncanny precision after her conversion she traveled with her family and other converts from the region to nauvoo illinois where the lds church was then based there she took a job as a servant in the home of joseph smith the founder and first prophet of the lds church when smith was killed in 1844 jane found employment as a servant in brigham young s home these positions placed jane in proximity to mormonism s most powerful figures but did not protect her from the church s racially discriminatory policies nevertheless she remained a faithful member until her death in 1908 your sister in the gospel is the first scholarly biography of jane manning james or for that matter any black mormon quincy d newell chronicles the life of this remarkable yet largely unknown figure and reveals why james s story changes our understanding of american history

a number of years ago in 2017 my wife denise and i celebrated our fiftieth wedding anniversary unlike many folks we didn t go to hawaii or on a european trip or anything like that for one reason we couldn t make plans well in advance though it was a milestone that few make in life we had family obligations that for us outweighed our celebration denise s mother was ill and my mother was already in hospice care we had no way of knowing how long that was going to last so we just lived our lives a day at a time as we always have they were both among the most important people on this earth to us along with our children we couldn t make plans to leave them behind and celebrate and so we didn t then a little more than two weeks before our fiftieth wedding anniversary my mother passed and our kids began to encourage us to go somewhere special we gave it thought and denise s family reunion was going to be right at the time we would be gone on our excursion if we left for our anniversary so we waited until the day of the family reunion of my wife denise before deciding where we were going with no reservations made with i believe inspiration from above we made our plan and left the day after denise s family reunion we were going to return to all the sights where we lived worked learned and grew together over the years of our marriage our children helped us make reservations while we were still at the family reunion we were headed for greenville south carolina to go back to the courthouse where we were married fifty years ago to see where we started and where the journey had begun after arriving that night we stayed just above the south carolina line in north carolina the next morning we headed for greenville and then we went on down to clemson university in clemson south carolina and watched the total eclipse of the sun it was an amazing sight to see and so fitting for our journey together that was august 21 2017 when we returned home i wanted to go back to where i had grown up as a child and we went to a church on fourteenth street in detroit for the services there when we left the parking lot that day i came up to the traffic light and looked across the street and in the distance i saw michigan central station it was where i started this journey when i arrived in the state of michigan when i was five years old and homeless i decided as i looked at that site this is my

life and this will be my book it is an amazing story and must be told it is against the odds

american millennials the generation born in the 1980s and 1990s have been leaving organized religion in unprecedented numbers for a long time the church of jesus christ of latter day saints was an exception nearly three quarters of people who grew up mormon stayed that way into adulthood in the next mormons jana riess demonstrates that things are starting to change drawing on a large scale national study of four generations of current and former mormons as well as dozens of in depth personal interviews riess explores the religious beliefs and behaviors of young adult mormons finding that while their levels of belief remain strong their institutional loyalties are less certain than their parents and grandparents for a growing number of millennials the tensions between the church s conservative ideals and their generation s commitment to individualism and pluralism prove too high causing them to leave the faith often experiencing deep personal anguish in the process those who remain within the fold are attempting to carefully balance the church s strong emphasis on the traditional family with their generation s more inclusive definition that celebrates same sex couples and women s equality mormon families are changing too more mormons are remaining single parents are having fewer children and more women are working outside the home than a generation ago the next mormons offers a portrait of a generation navigating between traditional religion and a rapidly

the myth of the twelve tribes of israel is the first study to treat the history of claims to an israelite identity as an ongoing historical phenomenon from biblical times to the present by treating the hebrew bible s accounts of israel as one of many efforts to construct an israelite history rather than source material for later legends andrew tobolowsky brings a long term comparative approach to biblical and nonbiblical israelite histories in the process he sheds new light on how the structure of the twelve tribes tradition enables the creation of so many different visions of israel and generates new questions how can we explain the enduring power of the myth of the twelve tribes of israel how does becoming israel work why has it proven so popular and how did it change over time finally what can the

changing shape of israel itself reveal about those who claimed it

who was king follett when he was fatally injured digging a well in nauvoo in march 1844 why did joseph smith use his death to deliver the monumental doctrinal sermon now known as the king follett discourse much has been written about the sermon but little about king although king left no personal writings joann follett mortensen king s third great granddaughter draws on more than thirty years of research in civic and church records and in the journals and letters of king s peers to piece together king s story from his birth in new hampshire and moves westward where in ohio he and his wife louisa made the life shifting decision to accept the new mormon religion from that point this humble hospitable and hardworking family followed the church into missouri where their devotion to joseph smith was refined and burnished king was the last mormon prisoner in missouri to be released from jail according to family lore king was one of the prophet s bodyguards he was also a danite a mason and an officer in the nauvoo legion after his death louisa and their children settled in iowa where some associated with the cutlerities and the rlds church others moved on to california one son joined the mormon battalion and helped found mormon communities in utah nevada and arizona while king would have died virtually unknown had his name not been attached to the discourse his life story reflects the reality of all those whose faith became the foundation for a new religion his biography is more than one man s life story it is the history of the early restoration itself

2016 best biography award john whitmer historical association younger brother of joseph smith a member of the quorum of the twelve apostles and church patriarch for a time william smith had tumultuous yet devoted relationships with joseph his fellow members of the twelve and the lds and rlds community of christ churches walker s imposing biography examines not only william s complex life in detail but also sheds additional light on the family dynamics of joseph and lucy mack smith as well as the turbulent intersections between the lds and rlds churches william b smith in the shadow of a prophet is a vital contribution to mormon history in both the lds and rlds traditions

in the mountains of beautiful bucolic northern utah many latter day saints mormons are visited by spirits local folklore is filled with stories of uncanny encounters of all kinds and latter day saint scripture and prophetic teachings emphasize the reality and the importance of the spirit world spirit encounters are common in this community people report visits from the benevolent spirits of kin offering aid and also from evil spirits who tempt and harass combining folklore research with ethnography the book examines many types of spirit encounters and shows that such experiences must be understood as particularly latter day saint phenomena spirit encounters take place within a larger cultural and religious framework that emphasizes the important relationships between living and non living beings for mormons in northern utah spirit lore and experiences are interpreted and understood with reference to latter day saint cosmology and particularly mormon conceptions of the nature of the

person the spirit and the family and the nature of righteousness evil and spiritual power the book also explores how people in utah differentiate between mormon culture the institutional church and how they understand the true meaning of the religion which has relevance far beyond understanding of people s relationship to the spirit realm and spirit power and speaks to key issues of concern and polarization among latter day saints today

the nineteenth century history of the church of jesus christ of latter day saints max perry mueller argues illuminates the role that religion played in forming the notion of three original american races red black and white for mormons and others in the early american republic recovering the voices of a handful of black and native american mormons who resolutely wrote themselves into the mormon archive mueller threads together historical experience and mormon scriptural interpretations he finds that the book of mormon is key to understanding how early followers reflected but also departed from antebellum conceptions of race as biblically and biologically predetermined mormon theology and policy both challenged and reaffirmed the essentialist nature of the racialized american experience the book of mormon presented its believers with a radical worldview proclaiming that all schisms within the human family were anathematic to god s design that said church founders were not racial egalitarians they promoted whiteness as an aspirational racial identity that nonwhites could achieve through conversion to mormonism mueller also shows how on a broader level scripture and history may become mutually constituted for the mormons that process shaped a religious movement in perpetual tension between its racialist and universalist impulses during an era before the concept of race was secularized

a gripping story of how an entire family deeply enmeshed in mormonism for thirty years found their way out and found faith in jesus christ for thirty years lynn wilder once a tenured faculty member at brigham young university and her family lived in loved and promoted the mormon church then their son micah serving his mormon mission in florida had a revelation god knew him personally god loved him and the mormon church did not offer the true gospel micah s conversion to christ put the family in a tailspin they wondered have we believed the wrong thing for decades if we leave mormonism what does this mean for our safety jobs and relationships is christianity all that different from mormonism anyway as lynn tells her story of abandoning the deception of mormonism to receive god s grace she gives a rare look into mormon culture what it means to grow up mormon and why the contrasts between mormonism and christianity make all the difference in the world whether you are in the mormon church are curious about mormonism or simply are looking for a gripping story unveiling grace will strengthen your faith in the true god who loves you no matter what
