this simple bengali folktale illustrating the power of faith was passed down from teacher to disciple from sri ramakrishna to swami vivekananda and from him to sister nivedita who recounted it in cradle tales of hinduism little gopal is afraid to walk alone through the forest to school his mother tells him call out to your cowherd brother he will come and protect you when gopal calls out to his delight a cowherd with dancing eyes appears and escorts him to school

the life of durgadas was one of the most extraordinary in the history of rajasthan women of marwar were often blessed with the words may you have a son like durgadas durgadas staked his all to preserve the throne of jodhpur after the death of king jaswant singh durgadas was a model rajput as wise as he was brave and a saviour of his land

this collection of buddhist tales tell of amrapali an accomplished dancer who commanded the love and admiration of an entire town and of upagupta who was just a poor monk amrapali craved peace upagupta s bearing exuded contentment amrapali depended on the adulation of her audience upagupta spurned the attentions of the rich and famous their stories were different but

the buddha s wise teachings linked their lives and the lessons to be learned from them

is there any end to want kesari the flying thief was delighted when he found a pair of flying shoes that would help him steal vasudeva was in a quandary as to how much money would satisfy all his needs and jinadatta hoped that his father in law would help him out of bankruptcy these tales told by jain monks in ancient times are as relevant today as they were long ago

as a little boy shatakarni or shalivahana as he was later called watched helplessly as he and his widowed mother were thrown out of their house by his father s brothers sheltered by a potter the boy grew up with the prophecy of a wandering sage ringing in his ears that he would one day become king the sanskrit classic kathasaritasagar and vikrama charita from which most of this story is taken traces the path that makes shalivahana so powerful that an entire era the shalivahana shaka was named after him

balarama is sure that duryodhana the kaurava prince with his skill in wielding the mace will be the ideal husband for his sister subhadra the princess however loses her heart to a handsome recluse who visits their palace little does she know that he is none other than the pandava prince arjuna and that he reciprocates her feelings it is left to her other brother krishna to understand the situation and solve the dilemma

ramanuja ad 1017 1137 lived for 120 years traversing the land from tamil nadu to kashmir people flocked to him to understand his unusual message the path to ultimate bliss high caste or low wealthy or poor ramanuja turned no one away the great acharya who wrote scholarly commentaries on sacred texts like the bhagavad gita was first and foremost a simple hearted devotee he inspired the bhakti movement that spread throughout the country

the entire maratha kingdom was shocked when sambhaji the son of shivaji joined forces with the mughal army shivaji s greatest foe sambhaji had a tough childhood his father was too busy to look after him and his mother died when he was only two the young sambhaji s main support came from his grandmother when she died he was bereft of love and care to make matters worse his step mother was campaigning to make her own son the next ruler trying to poison shivaji s mind against sambhaji this amar chitra katha traces the events that led up to the coronation of this wise and just maratha ruler

son of the beautiful goddess ganga the giver of life the lad was born to greatness not only was he handsome and wise he was also equally adept on the battlefield or in a regal court as this tale reveals bheeshma is best remembered for his exceptional honesty and kindness who else would have uncomplainingly suffered the trials of kingship without its comforts who else would have chosen long years of loneliness just to pander to a father s whim

the bandit wore a gruesome garland of fingers of the men he had killed as his garland of fingers

grew longer strong men cowered in fright the bandit was invincible until he met a gentle monk buddha thus darkness came face to face with light and at last the restless bandit found peace

bhanumati is the granddaughter of krishna one day wandering in the forest she runs into sage durvasa known for his short temper durvasa curses her to be abducted by a demon though durvasa regrets his words a curse once made cannot be taken back wh

born in the small town of rewari in present day haryana hemu a grocer s son had ambitions that took him beyond his world into the realm of politics intrigue and war an ambition that made him emperor of delhi hemu s rise to power is a fascinating story he relied entirely on his own intelligence and intuition he had to contend with political scheming and treachery in the courts of sher shah suri islam shah and finally adil shah with humayun and then akbar making a bid to regain the throne of delhi it was up to hemu to defend it

the british were ruthless they drained away the wealth of bengal to fill their own coffers in bankim chandra Chattopadhyay s 19th century tale holy men take up arms loving husbands abandon their families and demure housewives become wily spies to fight the reign of terror ananda math particularly its theme song vande mataram inspired an entire generation of idealistic young men and women to revolt against the british rule in india

shantala was the queen of vishnu vardhana the ruler of the hoysala kingdom brought up as a jain shantala believed in ahimsa or non violence her husband on the other hand had a single minded ambition to free hoysala from the rule of the chalukya empire whatever be the cost he waged wars and unleashed death and destruction on hapless people

kusha prince of kushavati was blessed with immense wisdom and extraordinary talent but he had the ugliest of faces the beautiful princess prabhavati was not aware of his ugliness when she married him kusha s mother saw to it that the princess never set eyes on her son s face but when she did prabhavati refused to have anything to do with her husband and went away leaving poor kusha broken hearted

when the child basava was born he did not cry or open his eyes for days according to sage jataveda who later became his guru basava had been in a yogic trance basaveshvara was a unique human being a reformer way ahead of his times eight hundred years ago at a time when society was ridden with the evils of a rigid caste system he spoke of equality and believed in the emancipation of women

the day was april 13 1919 it was the festival of baisakhi new year s day in the punjab when thousands of holidaying villagers mingled with the citizens of amritsar to listen to their leaders in amritsar s jallianwala bagh no one even imagined that the garden would turn into a killing field the british brigadier general reginald dyer in a bid to teach a moral lesson to the punjab ordered his

soldiers to open fire at the unarmed crowd of men women and children it was a turning point in india s struggle for freedom

jagdis chandra bose was the first indian scientist in modern times to have won international recognition gifted with a mind that was at once inquisitive and discerning bose wondered about the how and why of things from a very young age his contribution to the world of science was invaluable as the 1945 edition of encyclopedia britannica wrote his work was so much in advance of his time that its precise evaluation was not possible

tanaji malasure was only a boy when he took an oath to support his friend shivaji in fighting the mughals along with their small band of faithful followers they became a thorn in the side of the emperor aurangzeb as they conquered fort after fort tanaji s prowess was tested when he was entrusted with the near impossible task of capturing kondana fort the present story is based on shivasmruti by g s sardesai and shivaji the maratha his life and times by sir h g rawlinson

madhvacharya c 1238 1317 propagated the bhakti marg or the path of devotion for the realisation of god he felt that there was no need to deny the world in order to realise the divine relying on logic and quoting profusely from the scriptures he made a strong case for theism his school of thought is known as dvaita which stands for two realities independent and dependent the infinitely perfect god is independent and the world of matter and spirits is dependent on god he advocated total surrender to god to achieve salvation

he was known as a hardworking honest young cowherd but bappa rawal s bearing and talents were that of a well bred prince and one day he was to unite the divided rajput clans to regain their lost glory this gallant 8th century ruler of chittor lived to be a hundred years old enjoying his last years in the tranquillity of the remote himalayas

amidst the many wars he fought raja bhoja the ruler of malwa always found time to listen to poetry of the gifted ballala a poet in his court has immortalized his patron in his work bhoja prabandha which is a romantic tale written in sanskrit partly in verse and partly in prose ballala was interested not so much in history as in heroics in his attempt to magnify bhoja as a patron of the arts and letters ballala has ignored historical facts the poets kalidasa and bana who he said adorned bhoja s court actually lived much before bhoja s times

even the gods were charmed by this most honourable of kings fate had snatched away his palace his wealth his wife and his son worse sorrows were to pour down on him and yet harischandra would not abandon the righteous path he revealed the true mettle of a great king protecting his honour and that of his family with single minded determination

ganesha revered in india as the remover of obstacles is first and foremost an obedient son standing guard at his mother s door this son of parvati refuses to let anyone through even lord

shiva is denied entry this confrontation between father and son has one beneficial outcome the emergence of ganesha the elephant headed god of wisdom

prahlad drove his monstrous father to a murderous rage he insisted on praising lord vishnu who was considered a sworn enemy by his father hiranyakashipu when he tried to punish his disobedient son hiranyakashipu s potent poisons turned to nectar while his lethal weapons fell harmlessly away in this tale of bloodthirsty revenge prahlad s only defence is his devotion which dramatically puts an end to all evil

even the merciless lord yama is charmed by savitri this gentle beautiful princess is admired by gods and kings the rich and the poor the young and the old but when the shadow of death hangs over her husband she is filled with courage spurred by her selfless love for him she strives for a miracle with amazing success

as the king of varanasi lay dying he worried about his wife and unborn child the queen will be safe said his loyal minister ghoshthila she will bear a son who will one day rule over the kingdom reassured the king passed away but the prophecy had been overheard by the king s older son suryanemi the heir to the throne suryanemi thought of his unborn brother as a rival and ordered the minister to have the child killed as soon as it was born though it speaks of the indian kingdom of varanasi this story from india was preserved in the monasteries of the high frozen plateau of tibet it was found and translated by europeans in the nineteenth and twentieth centuries

he was from a respectable family well educated and a lawyer yet many indians thought of him as untouchable it was up to br ambedkar to teach his depressed community to fight the injustices that it faced each day hard working and wise he became the icon of the underprivileged history however will remember him as the architect of india s constitution

kalidas owes his fame to his sanskrit play abhijnana shakuntala shakuntala recognised by the token ring the long epic poem kumara sambhava birth of kumara and the lyric poem meghaduta cloud messenger kalidasa who lived some time in the middle of the 4th and early 5th centuries a d has left no account of his life according to popular legend he owed his ingenuity as much to goddess kali s blessings as to his own talents

king nala s life is idyllic until a cunning cousin tricks him out of his kingdom can the love of his beautiful damayanti survive such a calamity will they be able to win bisbn happiness full of twists and turns the story of this ideal couple is told in the mahabharata
